Advance Education at Los Rios

Steps to enrollment at Sacramento City College







Requirements:



Advanced education students must meet the following criteria:

- You are 16 or 17 years old or you have already completed 10th grade by the first day college classes start
- You are currently enrolled in high school (public, private, or home school)
- Your <u>unweighted</u> high school grade point average (GPA) is 2.7 or higher
- You must have permission from your parents and your school (Principal or Counselor) of attendance to participate

Enrollment steps

- Complete online application https://losrios.edu/admissions/get-started-and-apply
- Decide on courses to take https://losrios.edu/academics/search-class-schedules
- Complete the New Advanced Education (AE) form

- Email completed Advanced Education form to your counselor along with your typed statement (see page 2 of the AE form for details)
- Check your eservices account to verify enrollment and pay the universal transportation fees (a few dollars per unit)





- This is the start of your college transcript, pursue courses that you can successfully manage
- Be aware of your personal time restrictions and don't overextend yourself
- Make yourself aware of the Los Rios add/drop, withdrawal period and policy
- Withdrawing or failing a course can potentially delay your financial aid in the future
- Plan to purchase textbooks and other school related materials in advance (expect delays in shipping at this time)

Benefits

- Tuition is waived (except for the universal transportation fee and class expenses) free college:)
- You will also earn high school credit for completed courses:

1 college unit is equal to 3.33 high school credits, i.e when you pass POLS 301 (aka Government, a 3 unit class at SCC you will earn 10 H.S. credits. 5 of which will be applied to your government requirement and 5 will be applied to your elective requirements. The majority of community college classes qualify for an augmented (weighted) grade point
