What is the Full Circle Project (FCP)?

The Full Circle Project (FCP) is a program funded by the U.S. Department of Education and Sacramento State. FCP provides strong academic support, intentionally planned leadership options, and co-curricular service-learning incentives to engage in campus and community-based service activities.

Important Dates and Deadlines Checklist

- 1. Apply for admission to Sacramento State at <u>www.calstate.edu/apply</u> by December 4, 2020.
- 2. Apply for admissions to Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) when you apply to Sacramento State via <u>www.calstate.edu/apply</u> by December 4, 2020. Two letters of recommendations are required with your EOP application. These letters of recommendations are due by January 31, 2021.
- 3. Apply to Full Circle Project (FCP) at <u>http://bit.ly/fcpapp21</u> by March 1, 2021.
- 4. Apply to the Federal Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act Application as soon as possible. (Deadline is March 2, 2021)
- 5. Deadline to submit EOP Letter of Recommendations is January 31, 2021.
- 6. Sac State, EOP and FCP admission decision notifications will be sent out on March 1, 2021. Check your email regularly and check your My Sac State student center to complete any to-do list and clear any holds you may have.
- 7. Submit your FCP Confirmation Response by May 1, 2021.
- 8. If you're admitted to EOP, submit your Summer Bridge Packet and EOP Agreement Form by May 1, 2021.
- 9. Submit Intent to Enroll (ITE) to Sacramento State by May 1, 2021.
- 10. Submit official high school and college transcripts to Sacramento State as soon as possible.
