Purpose of school site council

Principal McMeekin described the purpose of school site council as a group of teachers, parents, administrators, students, and community members working together to develop and monitor the School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA). Galileo Perez volunteered to be a co-host of zoom to let individuals into the meeting and monitor the chat function. Sophia Kwong Kim offered to take minutes.

Review of current SPSA

Mr. McMeekin led a slide presentation of the 2020-21 SPSA. He reviewed the four goals and stated that he would like the SPSA to be a fluid document adopted with consensus from everyone. The four goals are:

Goal #1: By June 2021, all students will increase the career and college readiness rate as measured by the CA School Dashboard.

Goal #2: By June 2021, increase the percentage of students who respond positively on self awareness measures on the school climate survey.

Goal #3: By 2021, increase college and career readiness as measured on the CA Dashboard from 90.7% to 93%.

Goal #4: Support authentic parent and community engagement by providing varied opportunities for involvement.

Data Presentation

Mr. McMeekin shared data on the school's demographics, percentage of students meeting A-G requirements and attending college, percentages of students taking and passing Advanced Placement exams, and annual state English language arts and math (SBAC) assessment results.

English Learner (EL) Update

Ms. Jaime-Razo provided updates from recent District English Learner Advisory Committee (DLAC) meetings. Ms. Jaime-Razo noted that there are currently only 15 EL students at WC, but that 3/4 of students at the school were EL's at one time and have been redesignated.
